#### ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this 31st day of October, 1940.

THE RIGHT HON. P. FRASER PRESIDING IN COUNCIL.

Pursuant to section 10 of the Finance Act, 1938, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby order as follows:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Public Service Remuneration Order 1938, Amendment No. 2.
- 2. This Order shall be read together with and form part of the Public Service Remuneration Order 1938.\*
- 3. This Order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of October, 1940.
- 4. The Second Schedule to the Public Service Remuneration Order 1938 is revoked, and the following substituted:—

#### "SECOND SCHEDULE.

- "MINIMUM RATE OF REMUNERATION FOR MARRIED OFFICERS.
- " (a) For officers employed at an annual remuneration or annual rate of remuneration, £230 8s. 1d. per annum.
- "(b) For officers employed at an hourly remuneration or hourly rate of remuneration, 2s. 2½d. an hour.
- "(c) For officers employed at a remuneration or rate of remuneration otherwise fixed or computed, a rate proportionate to that set out in paragraph (a) of this Schedule."
