THE PUBLIC SERVICE REMUNERATION ORDER 1947

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this 5th day of
February, 1947

Present :

THE RIGHT HON. P. FRASER PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 10 of the Finance Act, 1938, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Public Service Remuneration Order 1947.
2. This Order shall be read together with and form part of the Public Service Remuneration Order 1946.*
3. This order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April, 1946.
4. The Second Schedule to the Public Service Remuneration Order 1946 is revoked, and the following substituted :—

“SECOND SCHEDULE

“MINIMUM RATE OF REMUNERATION FOR MALE MARRIED OFFICERS

“(a) For officers employed at an annual remuneration or at an annual rate of remuneration : £306 per annum.

“(b) For officers employed at an hourly remuneration or at an hourly rate of remuneration : 2s. 11½d. an hour.”
