# ORDER IN COUNCIL

THE PUBLIC SERVICE REMUNERATION ORDER (NO. 2) 1947

At the Government House at Wellington, this 19th day of November, 1947

#### Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to section 10 of the Finance Act, 1938, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby order as follows.

# ORDER

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Public Service Remuneration Order (No. 2) 1947.
- 2. This Order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of October, 1947.
- 3. On the coming into force of this Order, the Public Service Remuneration Order 1946,\* and the Public Service Remuneration Order 1947† are revoked.
- 4. The minimum rates of remuneration for male married officers employed in—
  - (a) The Public Service administered under the provisions of the Public Service Act, 1912; or
- (b) The Post and Telegraph Department—shall be—
  - (i) For officers employed at an annual rate of remuneration: £331 per annum.
  - (ii) For officers employed at an hourly rate of remuneration:3s. 2½d. per hour.
