THE PUBLIC SERVICE REMUNERATION ORDER (NO. 2) 1947

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington, this 19th day of
November, 1947

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 10 of the Finance Act, 1938, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby order as follows.

ORDER

1. This Order may be cited as the Public Service Remuneration Order (No. 2) 1947.

2. This Order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of October, 1947.

3. On the coming into force of this Order, the Public Service Remuneration Order 1946,* and the Public Service Remuneration Order 1947† are revoked.

4. The minimum rates of remuneration for male married officers employed in—

(a) The Public Service administered under the provisions of the Public Service Act, 1912; or

(b) The Post and Telegraph Department—
shall be—

(i) For officers employed at an annual rate of remuneration :
£331 per annum.

(ii) For officers employed at an hourly rate of remuneration :
3s. 2½d. per hour.
