## THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS SALARIES, ETC., REGULATIONS 1938.

## GALWAY, Governor-General. ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this 20th day of May, 1938.
Present:
The Right Hon. M. J. Savage presiding in Council.
Pursuant to the Education Act, 1914, His Excellency the GovernorGeneral, acting by and with the advice of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

## REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Public Schools Salaries, \&c., Regulations 1938.
2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the regulations made on the 12th day of January, 1925* (hereinafter referred to as " the principal regulations"), as amended from time to time.
3. These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of June, 1938.
4. Clause 4 of the principal regulations is amended by :-
(1) Deleting subclause (4) thereof, and substituting the following :-
" (4) The annual salary of a probationary assistant shall he $£ 135$ for a female and $£ 140$ for a male."
(2) Adding thereto the following additional sabclauses :-
" (5) A male probationary assistant who is married may, with the approval of the Minister, be paid a special allowance at a rate not exceeding the amount by which his salary is less than $£ 20915 \mathrm{~s}$.
" (6) A probationary assistant shall not be entitled to any salary or allowance other than that provided for in subclauses (4) and (5) hereof."
5. Clause 45 of the principal regulations is amended by adding thereto the words " but, with the approval of the Minister, a male relieving teacher who is married may be paid a special allowance at a rate not exceeding the amount by which his salary is less than $£ 20915 \mathrm{~s}$."
