Pursuant to section 19 of the Appropriation Act 1920, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

#### ORDER

- 1. (1) This order may be cited as the Public Service Salary Order 1951.
- (2) This order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April 1951.
- 2. The Public Service Salary Order 1950\* and the scale set out in the Schedule thereto of salaries payable to officers of the Professional Division and the Clerical Division of the Public Service administered under the Public Service Act 1912 are hereby revoked.
- 3. The scale set out in the Schedule hereto is hereby substituted for the scale hereby revoked.
- 4. The increments of the respective subdivisions of each of the classes shown in the said scale shall be annual increments:
- Provided that the maximum salary payable to any officer of the Professional Division or the Clerical Division may be fixed at the salary for any subdivision of a class.
