ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 16th day of May 1956

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE GOVERNMENT IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 19 of the Appropriation Act 1920, His Excellency the Administrator of the Government, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Public Service Salary Order 1956.

(2) This order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April 1956.

2. The scale set out in the Schedule hereto of salaries payable to officers of the Professional Division and the Clerical Division of the Public Service is hereby substituted for the scale prescribed by the Public Service Salary Order 1955.*

3. The increments of the respective subdivisions of each of the classes shown in the scale shall be annual increments:

Provided that the maximum salary payable to any officer may be fixed at the salary for any subdivision of a class.

4. (1) The Public Service Salary Order 1955* is hereby revoked.

(2) The subdivisions of Class Special in the Schedule to this order shall be deemed to correspond with the subdivisions of Class Special in the Schedule to the order hereby revoked as follows:
