THE PUBLIC SERVICE SALARY ORDER 1957

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 20th day of March 1957

Present:

THE RIGHT HON. S. G. HOLLAND PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 19 of the Appropriation Act 1920, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Public Service Salary Order 1957.

(2) This order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 19th day of November 1956.

2. The scale set out in the Schedule hereto of salaries payable to officers of the Professional Division and the Clerical Division of the Public Service is hereby substituted for the scale prescribed by the Public Service Salary Order 1956.*

3. The increments of the respective subdivisions of each of the classes shown in the scale shall be annual increments:

Provided that the maximum salary payable to any officer may be fixed at the salary for any subdivision of a class.

4. The Public Service Salary Order 1956* is hereby revoked.
