THE PUBLIC SERVICE SALARY ORDER 1960

COBHAM, Governor-General
ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 28th day of September 1960

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 19 of the Appropriation Act 1920, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Public Service Salary Order 1960.

(2) Except as provided in regulation 3 of this order, this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April 1960.

2. (1) The scale set out in the First Schedule hereto of salaries payable to officers of the Professional Division and the Clerical Division of the Public Service is hereby substituted for the scale prescribed by the Public Service Salary Order 1959 (No. 2).*

(2) This regulation and the said First Schedule shall continue in force until the 31st day of March 1961 and shall then expire.

3. (1) The scale set out in the Second Schedule hereto of salaries payable to officers of the Professional Division and the Clerical Division of the Public Service is hereby substituted for the scale set out in the First Schedule hereto.

(2) This regulation shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1961.

4. The increments of the respective subdivisions of each of the classes shown in the scales shall be annual increments:

Provided that the maximum salary payable to any officer may be fixed at the salary for any subdivision of a class.

5. The Public Service Salary Order 1959 (No. 2)* is hereby revoked.
