

## THE PUBLIC SERVICE SALARY ORDER 1960, AMENDMENT NO. 1

# COBHAM, Governor-General ORDER IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to section 19 of the Appropriation Act 1920, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

## ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Public Service Salary Order 1960, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Public Service Salary Order 1960\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

(2) This order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st

day of April 1961.

2. The Second Schedule to the principal order is hereby amended by omitting the figure "1,400" where it appears in relation to the first subdivision of Class Special, and substituting as the first subdivision of Class Special the figures "\( \) 1,300 \\ \) 1.400".

### EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect. This order alters the scale of salaries in the first subdivision of Class Special. It affects those officers whose salary and maximum in any scale issued under the Government Service Tribunal Act 1948 would otherwise extend over Class I and the first subdivision of Class Special.
