Pursuant to section 19 of the Appropriation Act 1920, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Public Service Salary Order 1961, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Public Service Salary Order 1961* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

(2) This order shall be deemed to have come into force on the

1st day of April 1961.

2. The Schedule to the principal order is hereby amended—

(a) By omitting the symbol "(3)" where it appears in relation to the annual salary for subdivision 8 of Class VI:

(b) By omitting note (3) at the foot of that Schedule.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect. This order has the effect of removing the initial maximum salary for female clerks, so that all female clerks in Class VI become entitled to the maximum salary for the class unless the Public Service Commission otherwise directs in terms of the proviso to clause 3 of the principal order.
