#### ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 22nd day of August 1962

#### Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to section 19 of the Appropriation Act 1920, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

#### ORDER

- 1. (1) This order may be cited as the Public Service Salary Order 1962.
- (2) This order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 26th day of July 1962.
- 2. The scale set out in the Schedule hereto of salaries payable to officers of the Professional Division and the Clerical Division of the Public Service is hereby substituted for the scale prescribed by the Public Service Salary Order 1961\* as amended by the Public Service Salary Order 1961, Amendment No. 1†.
- 3. The increments of the respective subdivisions of each of the classes shown in the scales shall be annual increments:

Provided that the maximum salary payable to any officer may be fixed at the salary for any subdivision of a class.

4. The Public Service Salary Order 1961\* and the Public Service Salary Order 1961, Amendment No. 1†, are hereby revoked.
