ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 31st day of July 1963

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to subsection (3) of section 43 of the State Services Act 1962 and section 19 of the Appropriation Act 1920, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. (1) This order may be cited as the Public Service Salary Order 1963.
- (2) This order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of August 1962.
- 2. This order shall apply only for the purpose of the classification and grading of officers of the Professional Division, and officers of the Clerical Division, of the Public Service who are not for the time being graded in accordance with section 43 of the State Services Act 1963.
- 3. The scale set out in the Schedule hereto of salaries payable to officers of the Professional Division, and officers of the Clerical Division, of the Public Service to whom this order applies in accordance with clause 2 hereof is hereby substituted for the scale prescribed by the Public Service Salary Order 1962.*
- 4. The increments of the respective subdivisions of each of the classes shown in the scales shall be annual increments:

Provided that the maximum salary payable to any officer may be fixed at the salary for any subdivision of a class.

5. The Public Service Salary Order 1962* is hereby revoked.
