THE PUBLIC SERVICE (SALARY SCALE) ORDER 1963

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 25th day of November 1963

PURSUANT to the State Services Act 1962, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Public Service (Salary Scale) Order 1963.
- (2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of December 1963.
2. The maximum amount of salary that the State Services Commission may prescribe under section 41 (4) of the State Services Act 1962 shall be £2,800 a year.
3. For the purposes of section 41 (12) of the State Services Act 1962, the jurisdiction of the Government Service Tribunal—
 - (a) Shall not extend beyond any salary for the time being payable to officers of subdivision 7 of Class Special of the Clerical Division of the Public Service; and
 - (b) Shall not in any case extend to any salary for the time being payable in respect of any position coming within the functions of the Advisory Committee on Higher Salaries in the State Services, as set out in section 19 of that Act, whether or not any such salary is less than any salary for the time being payable to officers of the said subdivision 7.
