PURSUANT to the State Services Act 1962, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Public Service (Salary Scale) Order 1963, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Public Service (Salary Scale) Order 1963* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

(2) This order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April 1964.

2. Clause 2 of the principal order is hereby amended by omitting therefrom the expression "£2,800", and substituting the expression "£3,100".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

These regulations amend the principal order so as to provide that the maximum salary rate which the State Services Commission has jurisdiction to prescribe is £3,100.
