**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

**HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL**

PURSUANT to the State Services Act 1962, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

**ORDER**

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Public Service (Salary Scale) Order 1963, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Public Service (Salary Scale) Order 1963 (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

(2) This order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April 1966.

2. Clause 2 of the principal order (as amended by clause 2 of the Public Service (Salary Scale) Order 1963, Amendment No. 1) is hereby further amended by omitting the expression "£3,100", and substituting the expression "£3,235".

3. The Public Service (Salary Scale) Order 1963, Amendment No. 1, is hereby revoked.
