THE PUBLIC SERVICE (EFFICIENCY TESTS) REGULATIONS 1937.

Enacting authority: The Public Service Commissioners with the approval of the Governor-General in Council.

Acts pursuant to which the regulations were made: The Public Service Act, 1912, and section 41 of the Finance Act, 1936.

Date on which the regulations were made: 5th day of November, 1937.

Date of approval by the Governor-General in Council: 10th day of November, 1937.

Date of notification in Gazette: 18th day of November, 1937.

REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Public Service (Efficiency Tests) Regulations 1937.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the regulations made under the Public Service Act, 1912, on the 31st day of March, 1913.*
- 3. These regulations shall come into force on the day following notification in the *Gazette* of the making and approval hereof.
- 4. Where it appears to the Commissioners to be desirable that officers in any group of the General Division should be tested by passing an examination before being allowed to proceed to a higher grade, the Commissioners may institute such an examination: Provided that the Commissioners may dispense with passing the examination if an officer has passed another examination which the Commissioners consider to be an adequate test of competence.
- 5. The syllabus for the examination will be prescribed by the Commissioners from time to time and will mainly cover subjects appertaining to the duties of the groups in which the officer seeks advancement.
- 6. The examination will be held at such times and places as may be fixed by the Commissioners who will give proper notice to applicants and will publish the syllabus at least six months prior to the date of the examination.
- 7. An officer who desires to submit himself for examination may make application for that purpose to the Commissioners through the Permanent Head of the Department in which the applicant is employed.

8. An officer passing the examination shall not be deemed eligible for promotion unless his conduct and efficiency is considered to be of a satisfactory standard and the Permanent Head of the Department concerned has certified accordingly.
