ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 13th day of May 1968

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Transport Act 1962, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Passenger-Service Vehicle Construction Regulations 1954, Amendment No. 8, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Passenger-Service Vehicle Construction Regulations 1954\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1968.

**2. Certificates of loading**—(1) Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting in subclause (1), after the definition of the term “body”, the following definition:

“‘Certificate of loading’, in relation to any passenger-service vehicle, means a certificate of loading in respect of that vehicle issued under the Transport Licensing Regulations 1963†:”.

(2) Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is hereby further amended by revoking the definition of the term “permit” in subclause (1).

(3) Regulation 8 of the principal regulations is hereby amended—

(a) By omitting from subclause (1) (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Passenger-Service Vehicle Construction Regulations 1954, Amendment No. 5) the words “certificate of fitness”, and substituting the words “certificate of loading”:

(b) By omitting from paragraph (a) of subclause (3) (as substituted by regulation 2 (1) of the Passenger-Service Vehicle Construction Regulations 1954, Amendment No. 6) the words “certificate or permit”, and substituting the words “certificate of loading”:

(c) By omitting from paragraph (b) of subclause (3) (as so substituted) the words “certificate of fitness or current permit”, and substituting the words “certificate of loading”:

(d) By omitting from subclauses (5), (7), and (8) (as substituted by regulation 2 (1) of the Passenger-Service Vehicle Construction Regulations 1954, Amendment No. 6) the words “certificate of fitness or permit”, and substituting in each case the words “certificate of loading”.

(4) Regulation 12 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from subclause (5) the words “certificate of fitness or permit”, and substituting the words “certificate of loading”.

(5) Regulation 25 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words “certificate of fitness or permit”, and substituting the words “certificate of loading”.

(6) Regulation 56 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words “certificates of fitness” and substituting the words “certificates of loading”.

(7) Regulation 105 of the principal regulations is hereby revoked.

(8) Regulation 107 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from paragraph (a) of subclause (1) the words “permit or certificate of fitness”, and substituting the words “certificate of loading”.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations substitute references to a certificate of loading (issued under the Transport Licensing Regulations 1963) for references to certificates of fitness or permits throughout the principal regulations.
