**THE PASSENGER SERVICE VEHICLE CONSTRUCTION

PURSUANT to section 199 of the Transport Act 1962, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Passenger Service Vehicle Construction Regulations 1978, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Passenger Service Vehicle Construction Regulations 1978* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Plan approval fee increased—(1) Regulation 5 (2) of the principal regulations (as amended by regulation 2 of the Passenger Service Vehicle Construction Regulations 1978, Amendment No. 2) is hereby amended by omitting the expression “\$144”, and substituting the words “\$175 (which

amount shall be exclusive of any goods and services tax payable under the Goods and Services Tax Act 1985)".

(2) The Passenger Service Vehicle Construction Regulations 1978, Amendment No. 2 are hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations increase, from \$144 to \$175, the fee payable when plans and specifications for a new passenger service vehicle are submitted to the Secretary for Transport for approval.
