THE PRIMARY TEACHERS' GRADING REGULATIONS 1926, AMENDMENT NO. 3.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 30th day of November, 1938.

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

Pursuant to the Education Act, 1914, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations shall be cited as the Primary Teachers' Grading Regulations 1926, Amendment No. 3.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the regulations made by Order in Council dated the 30th day of March, 1926 (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- 3. These regulations shall come into force on the day following notification in the *Gazette* of the making hereof.*
- 4. Notwithstanding the revocation of the Regulations for Public Schools: Salaries, Grading, Staffing, &c. (hereinafter referred to as the revoked regulations) by clause 5 of the Teachers' Salaries Regulations 1938, the grading of primary-school teachers in and for the year 1939 shall proceed as if the said regulations had, for the purposes of the grading of primary-school teachers only, remained in full force and effect.

- 5. Every teacher entitled to be graded in and for the year 1939 shall have assigned to him the salary which would have been payable to him under the revoked regulations, and such salary shall be deemed to be his salary for the purposes of placing him in a grading group as provided in clauses 4 (as substituted by Order in Council dated the 11th day of February, 1935) and 5 of the principal regulations.
- 6. If it is not possible to assign to any teacher a salary in accordance with the provisions of the last preceding clause, then the Director shall place any such teacher in such grading group as he considers proper.
