**THE PUBLIC TRUST OFFICE AMENDING REGULATIONS 1952**

PURSUANT to the Public Trust Office Act 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Public Trust Office Amending Regulations 1952, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the regulations made under the Public Trust Office Act 1908 and other Acts on the 20th day of August 1923* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. The fees payable by the Public Trustee under section 20 of the Public Trust Office Amendment Act 1913 on the filing in an office of the Supreme Court, after the commencement of these regulations, of an election under the provisions of section 15 of the Public Trust Office Act 1908 or of section 18 of the Public Trust Office Amendment Act 1913 or of section 45 of the Public Trust Office Amendment Act 1921-22 shall be as follows:—

- (a) Where the gross value (as estimated by the Public Trustee) of the property in New Zealand to which the election relates does not exceed £500 : 10s.
- (b) Where the gross value (as estimated by the Public Trustee) of the property in New Zealand to which the election relates exceeds £500 : £1.
