PURSUANT to the Public Trust Office Act 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Public Trust Office Amending Regulations 1958, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the regulations made under the Public Trust Office Act 1908 and other Acts on the 20th day of August 1923.*

2. Regulation 6 of the Public Trust Office Amending Regulations 1949†, as amended by regulation 2 of the Public Trust Office Amending Regulations 1956, is hereby further amended as from the 31st day of December 1957 by omitting the words “3¾ per cent” wherever they appear, and substituting in each case the words “4 per cent”.

3. The Public Trust Office Amending Regulations 1956‡ are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations increase from 3¾ per cent to 4 per cent the rate of interest payable on and after 1 January 1958 on money in the Common Fund of the Public Trust Office which is not at call.

Issued under the authority of the Regulations Act 1936.

Date of notification in *Gazette*: 30 January 1958.
