ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 27th day of October 1981

PURSUANT to section 4 of the Plant Varieties Act 1973, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Plant Varieties Act Extension Order 1981.
- (2) This order shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of its notification in the Gazette.
- 2. Application of Act—The Plant Varieties Act 1973 shall apply to all varieties and species of plants other than fungi, algae, and bacteria.
- 3. Revocation—The Plant Varieties Act Extension Order 1980* is hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order extends the application of the Plant Varieties Act 1973 to fully cover all plant varieties and species except for fungi, algae, and bacteria.
