Pursuant to section 4 of the Plant Varieties Act 1973, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Plant Varieties Act Extension Order (No. 2) 1976.
- (2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*,
- 2. Application of Act—(1) The Plant Varieties Act 1973 shall apply
 - (a) Annual ryegrass (Lolium multiflorum Lam.) on and after the 31st day of January 1977:
 - (b) Potatoes (Solanum tuberosum L.), field and garden peas (Pisum sativum L. sensu lato, P. arvense L.), and lucerne (Medicago sativa L.) on and after the 1st day of June 1977:
 - (c) Lotus (Lotus pedunculatus L., L. uliginosus Schkur, L. major, L. corniculatus L.) on and after the 30th day of September 1977.
 - (2) The Plant Varieties Act 1973 shall continue to apply to-
 - (a) Roses (Rosa L.):
 - (b) Barley (Hordeum vulgare L., H. vulgare L. convar, distichon (L)
 Alet.):
 - (c) Fodder-type perennial ryegrass (Lolium perenne L.).
 - 3. Revocations—The following are hereby revoked:
 - (a) Clause 3 of the Plant Varieties Act Commencement Order 1974*:
