PURSUANT to section 4 of the Plant Varieties Act 1973, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Plant Varieties Act Extension Order (No. 2) 1976, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Plant Varieties Act Extension Order (No. 2) 1976* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).
- (2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the Gazette.
- 2. Application of Act—Clause 2 of the principal order is hereby amended by omitting from paragraph (c) of subclause (1) the expression "L. corniculatus L."

This order removes one species of lotus from the species of lotus to which the Plant Varieties Act 1973 applies.
