ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 29th day of September
1975

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL BY HIS DEPUTY IN COUNCIL
PURSUANT to the Plant Varieties Act 1973, His Excellency the Governor-
General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive
Council, hereby—

- (a) Orders and declares that this Act shall apply to barley (*Hordeum vulgare*) as from the commencement of the Plant Varieties Regulations 1975, Amendment No. 1; and
- (b) Makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Plant Varieties Regulations 1975, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Plant Varieties Regulations 1975* (hereinafer referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Interpretation—Subclause (1) of regulation 2 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking the definition of the expression “species of plant variety”, and substituting the following definition:

“‘Species of plant variety’ means any genus to which the Act is, by Order in Council, declared to apply.”

3. Revocation—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the First Schedule.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of this instrument, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This instrument combines an Order in Council extending the Plant Varieties Act 1973 to barley, and regulations consequentially amending the Plant Varieties Regulations 1975. The amendments to the regulations are designed to avoid future amendments to the regulations when further plant varieties are brought under the Act. Test trial requirements are left to be covered under regulation 15 (1) (b) (ii) of the principal regulations.
