



**THE PLANT VARIETIES REGULATIONS 1975,
AMENDMENT NO. 3**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 10th day of June 1985

Present:

THE RIGHT HON. DAVID LANGE PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 37 of the Plant Varieties Act 1973, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Plant Varieties Regulations 1975, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Plant Varieties Regulations 1975* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Increase in fees payable—(1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Second Schedule (as substituted by regulation 3 of the Plant Varieties Regulations 1975, Amendment No. 2), and substituting the Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

(2) Regulation 3 of, and the Schedule to, the Plant Varieties Regulations 1975, Amendment No. 2 are hereby consequently revoked.
