PURSUANT to section 38 of the Plant Variety Rights Act 1987, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

**ORDER**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This order may be cited as the Plant Variety Rights (Fees) Order 1991, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Plant Variety Rights (Fees) Order 1991\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of June 1995.

**2. Schedule amended**—The First Schedule to the principal order is hereby amended by inserting in the heading of the second column, after the word “vegetables”, the word “, fungi”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

In 1994, the Plant Variety Rights Act 1987, was amended so as to extend its application to fungi. This order, which comes into force on 1 June 1995, amends the Plant Variety Rights (Fees) Order 1991, so as to apply the present fees payable for actions taken in respect of herbage, agricultural crops, and vegetables, to fungi.
