

THE PUBLIC WORKS (FEES FOR DOCUMENTS) REGULATIONS 1989

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 1st day of May 1989

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 243 (1) of the Public Works Act 1981, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Public Works (Fees for Documents) Regulations 1989.
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.
- 2. Amount of goods and services tax included—The fees fixed by these regulations are inclusive of goods and services tax under the Goods and Services Tax Act 1985.
- **3. Fees**—(1) The fees specified in the Schedule to these regulations are hereby prescribed as the fees payable in respect of the various matters referred to in that Schedule.
- (2) The said fees shall be paid by the person or body requesting the carrying out of the service, on invoice, to the Department of Lands or other person or body who or which carried out the service.

These regulations prescribe the fees payable for the preparation, checking, processing, and (where applicable) gazetting of various documents issued under the Public Works Act 1981.
