

THE PLASTIC WRAPPING REGULATIONS 1960. AMENDMENT NO. 1

Pursuant to the Health Act 1956, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Plastic Wrapping Regulations 1960, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Plastic Wrapping Regulations 1960* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date

of their notification in the Gazette.

2. Metric conversions—Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is hereby amended—

(a) By omitting from subclause (1) the expression "0.001 inch", and substituting the expression "0.025 mm":

(b) By omitting from subclause (2) the expression "25 square inches", and substituting the expression "162 square centimetres".
