THE QUARANTINE (AIR) REGULATIONS 1952,
AMENDMENT NO. 4

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 4th day of March 1968

PURSUANT to the Health Act 1956, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Quarantine (Air) Regulations 1952, Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Quarantine (Air) Regulations 1952* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. The First Schedule to the principal regulations (as amended by regulation 5 of the Quarantine (Air) Regulations 1952, Amendment No. 1 and regulation 2 of the Quarantine (Air) Regulations 1952, Amendment No. 3) is hereby further amended by omitting the references to "Evans Bay Airport" and "Mechanics Bay Airport".
