PURSUANT to section 62 of the Law Practitioners Act 1982, His Excellency the Administrator of the Government, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Queen's Counsel Regulations 1987, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Queen's Counsel Regulations 1987* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1992.

2. Fee increased—Regulation 4 (1) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the expression "\$245" (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Queen's Counsel Regulations 1987, Amendment No. 2), and substituting the expression "\$270".

3. Goods and services tax included—The fee prescribed by these regulations is inclusive of goods and services tax under the Goods and Services Tax Act 1985.

4. Revocation-The Queen's Counsel Regulations 1987, Amendment No. 2* are hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect. These regulations, which come into force on 1 July 1992, increase from \$245 to \$270 the fee payable on appointment as a Queen's Counsel. The fee prescribed is inclusive of goods and services tax.
