**THE QUARANTINE INSPECTION PLACES NOTICE 1981,
AMENDMENT NO. 1**

PURSUANT to section 94 of the Health Act 1956, the Minister of Health hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Quarantine Inspection Places Notice 1981, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Quarantine Inspection Places Notice 1981* (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).

(2) This notice shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1984.

2. Amendments of Schedule—The Schedule to the principal notice is hereby amended by omitting the items relating to Napier Harbour and Tauranga Harbour, and substituting the items set out in the Schedule to this notice.

SCHEDULE

PLACES OF INSPECTION

Napier Harbour

In a position on the southern heads, 1.25 miles east of the South Pania buoy.

Tauranga Harbour

In a position 075°T by 3.25 miles from the Mount Maunganui main light (FL.15 secs), that is in a position 37° 36.8'S 176° 14.3' E.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice redefines, in respect of Napier Harbour and Tauranga Harbour, the areas to which ships liable for quarantine may be taken while awaiting inspection.
