# THE QUARANTINE (AIR) REGULATIONS 1952, AMENDMENT NO. 3

PURSUANT to the Health Act 1956, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

## REGULATIONS

- 1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Quarantine (Air) Regulations 1952, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Quarantine (Air) Regulations 1952\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the Gazette.
- 2. The First Schedule to the principal regulations (as amended by regulation 5 of the Quarantine (Air) Regulations 1952, Amendment No. 1) is hereby further amended by inserting before the item "Christchurch Airport", the item "Auckland International Airport".

### EXPLANATORY NOTE

These regulations add Auckland International Airport to the list of sanitary aerodromes set out in the Schedule to the Quarantine (Air) Regulations 1952.
