THE QUARANTINE (SHIP) REGULATIONS 1957, AMENDMENT NO. 1

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to the Health Act 1956, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Quarantine (Ship) Regulations 1957, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Quarantine (Ship) Regulations 1957* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date

of their notification in the Gazette.

2. Paragraph (a) of regulation 4 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words "My ship is 'suspect' – i.e." and the words "My ship is 'infected' – i.e.".

3. Regulation 12 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting after the word "who", the words "pursuant to paragraph (b) of

regulation 11 hereof".
