

THE QUARANTINE (SHIP) REGULATIONS 1957, AMENDMENT NO. 2

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to the Health Act 1956, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Quarantine (Ship) Regulations 1957, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Quarantine (Ship) Regulations 1957* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.
 - 2. Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is hereby amended:
 - (a) By inserting, in their appropriate alphabetical order, the following definitions:

 "'Imported case' means any infected person arriving by

ship in New Zealand from any port beyond New Zealand:

- "Transferred case' means any infected person whose infection originated, or is believed to have originated, in another local area in New Zealand:":
- (b) By revoking paragraph (a) of the definition of "Infected local area" and substituting the following paragraph:
 - "(a) A local area where there is a case of plague, cholera, yellow fever, or smallpox which is neither an imported case nor a transferred case; or".
