**THE QUARANTINE (SHIP) REGULATIONS 1957,
AMENDMENT NO. 2**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 30th day of October 1963

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Health Act 1956, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Quarantine (Ship) Regulations 1957, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Quarantine (Ship) Regulations 1957* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is hereby amended:

(a) By inserting, in their appropriate alphabetical order, the following definitions:

“‘Imported case’ means any infected person arriving by ship in New Zealand from any port beyond New Zealand:

“‘Transferred case’ means any infected person whose infection originated, or is believed to have originated, in another local area in New Zealand:”:

(b) By revoking paragraph (a) of the definition of “Infected local area” and substituting the following paragraph:

“(a) A local area where there is a case of plague, cholera, yellow fever, or smallpox which is neither an imported case nor a transferred case; or”.
