THE QUARRIES REGULATIONS 1983, AMENDMENT NO. 2

ORDER IN COUNCIL

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Quarries and Tunnels Act 1982, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Quarries Regulations 1983, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Quarries Regulations 1983* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.
 - 2. Increasing fees—The principal regulations are hereby amended—
 - (a) By omitting from regulation 3 (2) the expression "\$10", and substituting the expression "\$25":
 - (b) By omitting from regulation 3 (2) the expression "\$5" in both places where it occurs, and substituting in each case the expression "\$10":

- (c) By omitting from regulation 4 (1) the expression "\$10", and substituting the expression "\$25":
- (d) By omitting from regulation 5 (1) the expression "\$10", and substituting the expression "\$25":
- (e) By omitting from form 1 in the Schedule the expression "\$10", and substituting the expression "\$25":
- (f) By omitting from the said form 1 the expression "\$5", and substituting the expression "\$10":
- (g) By omitting from form 2 in the Schedule the expression "\$10", and substituting the expression "\$25":
- (h) By omitting from form 3 in the Schedule the expression "\$10", and substituting the expression "\$25".
- **3. Other amendments**—The principal regulations are hereby amended—
 - (a) By omitting from regulation 3 (4) the words "Secretary of the Board, Mines Division of the", and substituting the words "Board of Examiners,":
 - (b) By omitting from regulation 3 (9) the words "who is not otherwise employed in a department of State".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

Regulation 2 of these regulations increases various application fees payable under the principal regulations.

Regulation 3 (a) omits a redundant reference to the Mines Division.

Regulation 3 (b) allows the payment of fees to examination supervisors notwithstanding that they are employed in a department of State.
