



**THE QUINNAT SALMON REGULATIONS 1940,
AMENDMENT NO. 1**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington, this 29th day of
August, 1945

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Fisheries Act, 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Quinnat Salmon Regulations 1940, Amendment No. 1.
2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Quinnat Salmon Regulations 1940* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations.)
3. These regulations shall come into force on the 2nd day of September, 1945.
4. Regulation 4 of the principal regulations shall henceforth be read with the addition thereto of the words "except in the Southern Lakes Acclimatization District and in the Rotorua Acclimatization District".
5. In any license hereafter issued in Form No. 1 in the Second Schedule to the principal regulations there shall be inserted, immediately following the words "inland waters", the words "except from the Southern Lakes Acclimatization District and the Rotorua Acclimatization District".
6. In any license hereafter issued in Form No. 3 in the Second Schedule to the principal regulations there shall be inserted, immediately following the words "inland waters", the words "except from the Southern Lakes Acclimatization District and the Rotorua Acclimatization District".
