**THE QUINNAT SALMON REGULATIONS 1963,
AMENDMENT NO. 1**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 3rd day of June 1975

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Fisheries Act 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Quinnat Salmon Regulations 1963, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Freshwater Fisheries Regulations 1951*.

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Metric amendments—The Quinnat Salmon Regulations 1963† are hereby amended—

- (a) By omitting from regulation 13 (c) the expression “ $\frac{1}{2}$ in.”, and substituting the expression “13 mm”;
- (b) By omitting from regulation 13 (d) the expression “15 in.”, and substituting the expression “38 cm”.
