ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 14th day of March 1977

PURSUANT to the Quantity Surveyors Act 1968, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Quantity Surveyors Regulations 1969, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Quantity Surveyors Regulations 1969* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Fees—(1) Regulation 17 of the principal regulations is hereby amended—

- (a) By omitting from subclause (1) the expression “\$25.00”, and substituting the expression “\$40.00”;
- (b) By omitting from subclause (2) the expression “\$5.00”, and substituting the expression “\$10.00”;
- (c) By omitting from subclause (5) the expression “\$10.00”, and substituting the expression “\$15.00”.

(2) Regulation 40 of the principal regulations (as inserted by regulation 2 of the Quantity Surveyors Regulations 1969, Amendment No. 1) is hereby amended by revoking subclause (2), and substituting the following subclause:

“(2) The fee for the written examination shall be \$10.00 per paper.”

3. Forms—The Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended—

- (a) In Form 3, by omitting the expression “\$25.00”, and substituting the expression “\$40.00”:
- (b) In Form 3, by omitting from paragraph (2) the word “technical” (in the second place where it appears), and substituting the word “my”:
- (c) In Form 4, by omitting the expression “\$10.00”, and substituting the expression “\$15.00”:
- (d) In Form 8 (as inserted by regulation 3 of the Quantity Surveyors Regulations 1969, Amendment No. 1), by omitting from paragraph 6 the expression “\$15.00”, and substituting the expression “\$.....”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations increase the fees for applications for registration, registration, and annual practising certificates, and alter the fees payable for written examinations. Minor changes are also made to the forms in the Schedule.
