PURSUANT to regulation 13(1) of the Secondary School Boards Administration and Employment Regulations 1965, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Queen Victoria School Board of Governors Election Validation Order 1985.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Validation of unlawful election—Notwithstanding that an election of parent representatives for the Board of Governors of Queen Victoria School was required by regulation 7 of the Secondary School Boards Administration and Employment Regulations 1965 to be held not later than the 23rd day of July 1985, the holding of that election on the 10th day of August 1985 is hereby validated.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order validates the holding of an election for parent representatives for the Board of Governors of Queen Victoria School in Auckland. The election was required by law to be held not later than 23 July 1985 but was not held until 10 August 1985.
