PURSUANT to the Rabbits Act 1955, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Rabbit Destruction Regulations 1958, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Rabbit Destruction Regulations 1958* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. The First Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended—
- (a) By omitting the word “Kawarau”, as inserted by regulation 2 of the Rabbit Destruction Regulations 1958, Amendment No. 1, and substituting the word “Kawarau”;
- (b) By inserting therein in their appropriate alphabetical order the items set out under the following headings:
