PURSUANT to the Public Revenues Act, 1926, and the Justices of the Peace Act, 1927, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Regulations for Payment of Witnesses 1931, Amendment No. 4.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Regulations for Payment of Witnesses 1931* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).
- 3. These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of January, 1946.
- 4. Paragraph (2) of Regulation 2 of the principal regulations (as substituted by the Regulations for Payment of Witnesses 1931, Amendment No. 3†) is hereby amended as follows:—
 - (a) By substituting in lieu of the expressions—
