Order

1 Title

This order is the Resource Management (Earlier Expiry of Moratorium—Central Pegasus Bay) Order 2004.

2 Commencement

This order comes into force on 14 October 2004.

3 Interpretation

In this order, **moratorium** has the same meaning as in section 150A of the Resource Management Act 1991.

4 Earlier expiry of moratorium in relation to Pegasus Bay

The date specified as the date on which the moratorium ends in relation to the area in central Pegasus Bay described in the Schedule is 14 October 2004.

Description of area in central Pegasus Bay

The area referred to in clause 4—

- (a) is situated in the coastal marine area in Pegasus Bay; and
- (b) is a quadrilateral area of 2 695 ha, the corners of which are defined by the intersections of the following New Zealand map grid co-ordinates:
 - (i) 5764449.1 mN and 2500254.8 mE (NW corner):
 - (ii) 5764413.0 mN and 2505549.7 mE (NE corner):
 - (iii) 5759323.6 mN and 2505514.0 mE (SE corner):
 - (iv) 5759359.7 mN and 2500220.1 mE (SW corner).

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on 14 October 2004, specifies 14 October 2004 as the date for the earlier expiry of the moratorium in relation to central Pegasus Bay, an area of 2 695 ha situated in the Canterbury region coastal marine area.

The moratorium, which began on 28 November 2001, prevents a consent authority from processing or determining applications for coastal permits for aquaculture activities.

Without this order the moratorium in relation to central Pegasus Bay would have continued in force until 31 December 2004.
