**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations revoke regulations that prohibit the keeping of live poultry in the central portion of the City of Wellington. The keeping of live poultry in that city is now covered by bylaws of the Wellington City Council.
