ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 13th day of April 1959

Present:

THE RIGHT HON. W. NASH PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Samoa Act 1921, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby revokes the Samoa Bank of New Zealand Order 1920,* and declares that this revocation shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April 1959.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order is consequential on the establishment of the Bank of Western Samoa, which will commence business in Western Samoa on the same date, and the Bank of New Zealand will then cease to operate in Western Samoa.
