# THE ROTORUA TROUT-FISHING REGULATIONS 1939, AMENDMENT NO. 3

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to the Fisheries Act, 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

#### REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Rotorua Trout-fishing Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 3.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Rotorua Trout-fishing Regulations 1939\* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).
- 3. These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of October, 1945.
- 4. Regulation 35 of the principal regulations is amended by inserting therein, next following paragraph XI of clause 3 thereof, the following paragraph:—
- "(XIA) That part of the Waioeka River from Hamilton's swing bridge to its confluence with the Oponae Stream."
