Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Fisheries Act, 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Rotorua Trout-fishing Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 3.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Rotorua Trout-fishing Regulations 1939* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).

3. These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of October, 1945.

4. Regulation 35 of the principal regulations is amended by inserting therein, next following paragraph XI of clause 3 thereof, the following paragraph :—

“(XIA) That part of the Waioeka River from Hamilton’s swing bridge to its confluence with the Oponae Stream.”
