2. The State Advances Corporation of New Zealand Account is hereby declared to be subject to Part IX of the Public Revenues Act 1953.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

This order provides that the State Advances Corporation of New Zealand Account is to be subject to Part IX of the Public Revenues Act 1953. That Part of that Act relates to accounts that are outside the Public Account.
